

CARLINVILLE - Macoupin County State's Attorney Jennifer A. Watson announced today that a charge of Aggravated DUI has been filed against 24 year old Ralph S. Glenn (DOB 9/2/1986) of Girard, for a car crash that cause the death of Patrick T. Jones, Jr. Judge Joshua A. Meyer set the bond at \$25,000 with 10% to apply.

Aggravated DUI involving a death is a class two felony with a sentencing guideline of up to 14 years in the Illinois Department of Corrections.

The information alleges that on November 21, 2010, Mr. Glenn crashed a 2008 Pontiac G6 on Kimes Road in Macoupin County. Mr. Jones died from injuries sustained from the crash. The information further alleges Mr. Glenn was driving while under the influence of alcohol, where the alcohol concentration in his blood was 0.08 or more at the time of the crash.

"It is alleged that Mr. Jones lost his life due to another's drinking and driving," commented Watson. "Our thoughts and prayers are with Mr. Jones' family. My office hopes through vigorous prosecution of all DUIs no other family will have to experience this tragedy."

The public is reminded that a defendant is presumed innocent. This information contains only charges and is not proof of the defendant's guilt.
