

CARLINVILLE - Macoupin County State's Attorney Jennifer A. Watson announced today that a Medora woman was charged in a traffic crash resulting in the death of her mother. Caylee N. Durham, 20 (9/15/1995), was charged with Aggravated Driving Under the Influence of Drugs. Judge Joshua A. Meyer set bond at \$30,000 with the 10% rule to apply.

It is alleged that on March 21, 2016, Ms. Durham operated a 2005 Honda Coupe on Chesterfield Road, South of Victory Road while under the influence of a drug which caused a motor vehicle crash that resulted in the death of another person, Angela Williams.

"This is a tragic, but all too familiar situation," commented State's Attorney Watson. "This is an unnecessary death. Ms. Williams should be alive today."

As charged, Aggravated Driving Under the Influence of Drugs is a class 2 felony with a maximum prison sentence of 14 years.

The public is reminded that a defendant is presumed innocent. This information contains only charges and is not proof of the defendant's guilt.
