

CARLINVILLE- Macoupin County State's Attorney Jennifer A. Watson announced today that two men have been charged with kidnapping from an incident that took place in Girard. Thomas J. Castagno (11/01/1978) and Cory A. Fuiten (10/28/1978), both of Virden, IL, were charged with two counts of aggravated kidnapping , one count of aggravated battery, and one count of aggravated unlawful restraint. Judge Kenneth R. Deihl set bond for each individual at \$250,000 with the %10 rule to apply.

It is alleged that on June 8, 2011 that Kyle Adams was kidnapped by Thomas J Castagno and Cory A. Fuiten. It is further alleged that Mr. Adams was unlawfully restrained and battered with a baseball bat in the course of the kidnapping.

Aggravated kidnapping is a class X felony with a maximum prison sentence of 30 years. Aggravated battery and aggravated unlawful restraint are both class 3 felony with a maximum prison sentence of 5 years.

The public is reminded that a defendant is presumed innocent. This information contains only charges and is not proof of the defendant's guilt.
